Unlike other student societies, OFS does not charge students for membership or attending our events, as we strongly believe that finance should be made accessible to students from all backgrounds.

OFS currently has around 4,000 active members. Our membership is incredibly diverse, and we encourage students from all parts of the university to get involved.

We have members from all of Oxford's 44 colleges and halls and we are proud that we have close to a 50:50 ratio of men to women, one of the most representative. Our membership includes both undergraduates and postgraduates, studying both traditional and non-traditional financial subjects.

Community is integral to what we do and we encourage all our members to become actively involved with the society. We pride ourselves on being inclusive and representing the best interests of our members, which in turn allows us to give honest and impactful advice to our sponsors.

In line with our aim of making finance accessible to all, we regularly run events which

promote careers in finance to students from backgrounds typically underrepresented in the industry. Our newly created Outreach Officer committee position ensures that our efforts have the maximum impact possible.

We're constantly striving to grow, with a target of 5,000 members this year. We're aiming to achieve this through new, innovative marketing techniques and an even more ambitious schedule of events. Our most successful posts have a reach of up to 10,000 students across Oxford on social media. We plan to continue expanding our reach even further.

This year, we have created a brand new website for the Oxford Finance Society, including the first ever Annual Report, and a new comprehensive Careers Guide. This will make it easier for our members to navigate the world of finance and make the most of their OFS membership. The scale and ambition of our events programme is also increasing. The upcoming terms are set to be our busiest yet with bigger and better speaker events, panel discussions, and networking socials than ever before.

# COLLEGIATE SYSTEM

Oxford University is divided into 39 Colleges and 6 Private Permanent Halls. Unlike many universities in the United Kingdom, this means much of both the academic and the social aspects of the University is de-centralized into individual colleges. - Careers and Development: ensures members have access to resources and opportunities to develop their knowledge and skills.





# MEET OUR SPEAKERS



**XAVIER ROLET**

**On Running an \$18bn Hedge Fund**

Since becoming the CEO of the London Stock Exchange in 2009, Xavier Rolet turned the LSE from a mid-tier trading venue into a global superpower worth \$13 billion, sixteen times greater than its initial value. Last year saw him return to the world of high finance as the CEO of CQS, one of the largest hedge funds in the world managing \$18 billion.

Rolet began his career in finance in Goldman Sachs & Co, joining in 1984, later becoming co-head of Equity Sales and

Trading. Thereafter, he went on to join Credit Suisse before moving to Dresdner Kleinwort Benson. Prior to his role at the LSE, he served as the CEO of Lehman Brothers in France.

His expert lecture with Oxford Finance Society discussed the running of an \$18bn Hedge Fund, the future of the financial industry, and of capitalism itself.

**DR PETER CIRENZA**

**A macro historical perspective on contemporary issues**

A former partner of Goldman Sachs & Co., Dr Cirenza complements his vast industry experience with the expertise of an economic historian. Alongside his teaching at the London School of Economics, he is the head of the London operations of Tikehau Capital, a \$26bn private equity fund. Dr Cirenza overlooked the development of Goldman's principal finance and special situations investing division. His activities focused on real estate, private equity as well as M&A and corporate and structured finance. Dr Cirenza's academic career has been equally impressive. Doctor in Economic History, he is a leading global capacity on financial and economic history, publishing extensively on the topic.

His enlightening talk with the Oxford Finance Society provided a complex analysis of the current macroeconomic and investment environment under a macro historical lens. This was a highly informative and engaging event.





## BOB DIAMOND

### Ex-CEO of Barclays: The highs and lows of his 30-year experience as a world-leading banker

Mr Diamond has made a name for himself through a range of almost legendary deals, as well as his temperament and extraordinary charisma. He led the extremely bold and successful purchase of Lehman Brothers' assets in the US after the bank filed for bankruptcy in 2008, a move which immediately gave Barclays a strong global presence. Within his 16 years at the company, Mr Diamond built up Barclays into a leading player in the industry worldwide, and a jewel of Britain's banking sector. Bob Diamond quickly rose

through the ranks at Morgan Stanley and then Credit Suisse First Boston, before winding up at Barclays in 1996. Joining as the head of Barclays Capital, the investment banking branch, as well as a chief executive of corporate banking and wealth management, Mr Diamond inherited an ailing company on the verge of global irrelevance. Within 3 years, he turned Barclays investment banking into a world-leading trading and capital markets house, as the bank grew at 20% per year for over a decade under his supervision. In 2011, Mr Diamond became the CEO of the entire Barclays group, only to be ousted the year after due to the bank's involvement in the Libor scandal.

His event with the Oxford Finance Society was a great success, as expected. It was one of the most anticipated and well-attended events of the year; a true highlight to mark the end of another decade with OFS.

## RETO FRANCIONI

### In discussion with Mr Francioni: UBS Director, CocaCola HBC Director, and Ex-CEO of Deutsche Börse

A world-class expert on financial markets infrastructure and a professor of applied capital markets at the University of Basel, Mr Francioni gained prominence thanks to his highly successful 10-year tenure as the CEO of Deutsche Börse, the Frankfurt-based global stock exchange valued at almost \$30bn. He is nowadays the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Swiss Air, and plays an active role on executive and supervisory boards of companies employing over 120,000 people across the world, including UBS, Coca Cola HBC or SIX Swiss Exchange.

Our new 'In Discussion with' format, launched with this event, brings together a specialist, finance-related talk with a highly exclusive networking opportunity with top financiers, CEOs and policy makers across the world. Mr Francioni gave an expert talk drawing on his 30 years of both practical and academic experience in the financial world, and sharing his perspective on the current state and potential future of the financial services industry. After, attendees had the opportunity to engage in debate with the speaker, ask questions and hear more about career opportunities with UBS from one of the most qualified person in the world. This event was highly selective, with attendees invited after submission of their CVs. This new event format proved extremely successful, and will definitely become a staple of OFS events for years to come.



## **GRAEME WHEELER**

The 'Crisis Manager': why \$500bn has not solved global poverty

At the forefront in the field of public finance and economic policy-making, Graeme Wheeler served as the Governor of the Reserve Bank of New Zealand until 2017. Meanwhile, he was also the managing director of the World Bank, helping to tackle global poverty whilst overseeing a 12,000 people staff and committing \$73bn every year for development aid. As a current board member of China's Construction Bank, he sits in the front row as China leads the rebalancing of the global economy and finances infrastructure projects on a scale not seen for decades. Lastly, he served as an advisor both for the private sector and the Russian government during the country's privatisation.

Starting with the discussion of the 'Washington consensus' and its 'Beijing' counterpart, Mr Wheeler explored why the \$500bn in World Bank's cumulative spending has not been enough to solve global poverty, and what should be done next. Mr Wheeler drew on his experiences with China's Construction Bank and his work with the central bank of New Zealand, which has a long-standing reputation for cutting-edge innovative approaches to economic policymaking. Thereafter, Mr Wheeler discussed the future challenges policymakers will face when steering the global economy, ranging from global environmental degradation to public sector indebtedness or underfunded pension schemes. This unique event gave attendees the chance to openly engage in discussion with the speaker and ask questions relevant to economic policymaking, the global economic system, or cricket - yet another of Mr Wheeler's big passions!

## **STEVE MOBBS**

From Oxford graduate to billion dollar hedge fund titan



Steve Mobbs is an Oxford graduate and the founding partner of the impressively successful Oxford Asset Management, a \$5bn quantitative hedge fund based in Oxford which he built up from scratch into one of the 10 largest funds in Europe. Starting OxAm with a group of friends and \$10m under management in the early 2000s, Mr Mobbs now commands over a hundred employees and 500x as much money. Prior to OxAM, he had a highly successful career with BP, Bank of America, CSFB and Deutsche Bank, where he was the MD for proprietary trading.

Reflecting on his 35 years in the financial world, Mr Mobbs shared his priceless perspective on career prospects in the financial industry coming from a man who knows Oxford through-and-through. In addition, he gave advice on how to build your own hedge fund, how to simultaneously manage billions of dollars and 100+ traders, and how the computer has disrupted the financial industry by opening exciting new trading strategies.




